While Canada watches closely, Hollywood IATSE Members voted overwhelmingly to strike. The International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees (IATSE), which represents some 60,000 off-screen workers like camera operators, makeup artists, and production assistants, said that 90 per cent of its members cast ballots and more than 98 per cent of the votes returned were in favour of authorizing a strike.
