Re: Lamb property in Okanagan Falls

Dear Mr. Pendergraft

In 2015, after approval by way of a borrowing referendum, two properties were purchased for parks—one in Okanagan Falls and one in Heritage Hills. Since then, Heritage Hills has been developed into a beautiful park while the Lamb property remains rented to a third party at approximately \$1,400 per month. The rental income isn't close to the interest cost being paid on the debt.

We recognize that the RDOS Parks and Recreation staff have many projects that they oversee and acknowledge that consultants have recently been hired to complete an Area D Master Parks Plan. Our purpose in writing, on behalf of the residents of Okanagan Falls, is to remind the Board that the property was purchased for public use and to ask that once the Master Parks Plan is complete, consultation with residents on converting the Lamb property into public use is a priority.
