An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) because of the potential danger to health, safety, and life due to the threat of the **August Lake Wildfire**.

The **AMENDED EVACUATION ALERT** is for the following areas:

- **South of Highway 3**
- **West to Amber Hill Road / Darcy Mountain Road adjacent of Sewer Treatment Plant**
- **East to Willies Ranch Road**
- **Includes Princeton Golf Club and Properties on Taylor Mill Drive**
- **Properties north of Highway 3 along the Similkameen River**
- **South of Princeton Cemetery Road**
- **East of Copper Mountain Road**
- **West of Willie Ranch Road**

This Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should an evacuation order be made. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible before evacuation is ordered; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.
