

Recreation Program Instructor Children/Youth and Families Contract Position

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen is currently looking for qualified Recreation Program Instructors, on a contract basis, to join our Recreation Team in facilitating in-person and virtual recreation experiences in physical, social, intellectual, and creative pursuits for children, youth, and families.

As a Program Instructor, you will be responsible for instructing and supervising programs (including special events) for children/youth ages 0-16 years, as well as families, in a variety of locations within the Regional District. These locations could include: Naramata, West Bench, Kaleden, Okanagan Falls, and Keremeos. Fall programming will focus primarily on outdoor play, sport and creativity and will be restricted to current COVID-19 public health orders.

Working within the Community Services (Recreation) Department, you will be responsible for:

- Preparation and instruction of programs as directed by the Recreation Coordinator or Recreation Programmer.
- Leading and supervising a variety of activities, with safety being the priority at all times.
- Building positive rapport with all children and their families.
- Establishing and maintaining open communication with parents/caregivers and colleagues.

The work schedule will be dependent upon program needs, however, the hours are work are anticipated to be primarily after school, evenings, and weekends.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience working with children/youth/families in recreation, education, or social services.
- Minimum of one (1) year of related experience.
- Valid First Aid and CPR-C or willingness to obtain certifications.
- High Five certification or Physical Literacy training are assets.
- Demonstrated leadership abilities.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Completion of a satisfactory criminal record check.
- Valid BC Driver's Licence.
