Electoral Area “A” Open House – Official Community Plan Update

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) will be holding an open house for the Electoral Area “A” Official Community Plan (OCP) bylaw review at the Sonora Community Centre (8505 68 Avenue, Osoyoos) on Monday, September 21 from 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm. COVID-19 protocols will be in place and anyone attending is encouraged to wear a mask.

“The last OCP review was done in 2004,” notes Director Pendergraft. “We haven’t had significant changes in our area, but it is important to continue planning for our future so we want to hear from all the communities within Electoral Area “A.” The draft bylaw has been updated to reflect new information, data and concerns. Included is a new community vision and existing goals have been refreshed to form the basis of the policies throughout the OCP.

“An Official Community Plan is the vision a community has for its future,” says RDOS Chair Karla Kozakevich. “The goals and policies set out in the plan help guide decisions made by the Board of Directors about future land use.”
