

## **LOOKING GOOD IN VIRTUAL MEETINGS**

- Adjust the webcam frame to show your face, shoulders, and upper chest.
- Elevate your camera to eye level. Place your camera or laptop on a stack of books if necessary. This keeps your face and chest in proportion.
- Illuminate your face. Avoid backlight or sidelight. If you can, sit facing a big window.
- Be aware of your video background/surroundings. People are looking into your home or office.
- When speaking, focus on the camera or your meeting participants, not on yourself.
- Mute yourself when you are not speaking.
- Avoid solid black, solid white, or wild-patterned clothing.
