2. If your application is filled out correctly, the Regional District will send you a mail ballot package once we have received the ballots.

Following receipt of the mail ballot, you are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is received at the Regional District Office **no later than 4:30 pm on October 14, 2022 or by 8 pm on General voting day, Saturday, October 15, 2022 at the polling station for the Electoral Area in which you are voting.**

18 years of age or older on October 15, 2022; **and**

- A Canadian citizen;
- A resident of the Electoral Area **OR** a non-resident registered owner of real property in the Electoral Area for at least 30 days prior to voting day (September 14, 2022);
- A resident of BC for at least 6 months prior to voting day (April 14, 2022);
- Not disqualified by law from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.
