



Notice to PIB Community and Guests:

The Penticton Band Administration has received another report on what is believed to be a second cougar attack on family pets in the Westhills Subdivision area.

As a precaution in keeping our community members, children and your pets safe, the PIB Administration are coordinating with the Natural Resources Department and our Band Council to put into place swift action plans on how to best deal with this dangerous threat.

The area where the two recent animal attacks occurred is in the south east area of Westhills Subdivision and not far from our Outma School. The school has been advised and they have implemented safety plans to ensure our children's safety. See the map below for location. **For residents living in the area, please do not let your children or pets play or walk to school outside, alone.**

In the frequented area, the public may see our Natural Resources Team and trackers in the effort to contain the animal. **Please do not approach the personnel in the conduct of their duty as it may add unnecessary risk.**

A public notice will be posted with updates as our responsibility to the land and our people is carried out.
