That survey allowed you to express your satisfaction toward the present governance framework for services, and to offer suggestions for improvement. The results from the Forums and Survey have now been collated and we are ready to look at options.

Your responses to the Survey and Governance Forums have led the Governance Committee and Consultants to develop a series of options that consider ways in which governance and delivery of services in Area "D" might be improved. A second survey (Survey #2) will ask you to select which you consider the best of these options.

> The options, prepared in the form of "RDOS Area "D" Governance Study Option Fact Sheets" cover the five topics of: Regional District Service Levels; Local Community Commissions; Electoral Area Boundary Options; Roads & Policing Provincial Service Levels; and Water Authority Collaboration. The Option Fact Sheets are available online at www.rdos.bc.ca or in print at locations in each community (see below). After becoming

familiar with the Option Fact Sheets, the public will be asked to participate in a second survey (Survey #2) in order to select which they consider to be the best of these options.

Once the surveys are analyzed and public preferences from the options are determined, the preferred options will be presented to the RDOS Board in a report which will identify the range of issues of greatest concern to the citizens of Area "D" communities, and a consideration of changes to governances and services in order to address those issues.
