REGIONAL DISTRICT OF OKANAGAN-SIMILKAMEEN BYLAW NO. 2105, 2001

A bylaw to establish a solid waste collection service

Whereas the Regional District has adopted, and the Minister of Water, Land and Air Protection has approved, a Regional Solid Waste Management Plan; and

Whereas the Regional District wishes to establish a solid waste collection service including the collection of recyclable materials in the Campbell Mountain rural area;

The Board of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Campbell Mountain Landfill Solid Waste Collection Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2105, 2001.
- 2. A service for the collection of solid waste and recyclable materials from improved single family residential properties and improved single family strata lots is established.
- 3. The boundaries of the service area are shown outlined in heavy black on Schedule "A" to this bylaw.
- 4. Electoral Areas D, E and F include participating areas for the service.
- 5. The annual cost of the service established by this bylaw shall be recovered by way of user fees imposed under s.797.2 of the Local Government Act or by the requisition of money in the Service Area pursuant to section 806 of the Local Government Act, to be collected by a property value tax to be levied on land and improvements for regional hospital district purposes within the participating areas and to be collected in accordance with section 806.1 of the Local Government Act, or by a combination of the two methods.
- 6. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the Service shall not exceed \$550,000.
