- Highway 97 south of 9th Avenue -








Figure 1: Town Centre Plan Study Area

- Intersection and Sidewalk Upgrades.








Proposed "Place Magnet" Concept.










New Development Permit Guidelines:

Orient buildings on a north-south axis to optimize sunlight;


Design buildings to an appropriate scale;

Pedestrian-oriented ground floor, etc.

Option No. 1 – Status Quo


- least intrusive option;
- retain Commercial (C) designation;
- rename C4 Zone to eliminate confusion with new "Town Centre" Zone;
- would continue to encourage densities & mixed-use types of development outside of "Town Centre" area.




Options No. 2 – OCP designation/zone review

- explore replacing commercial designation / zone with:
 - Medium Density Residential
 - Administrative and Institutional; and
 - > Tourist Commercial.
- Seen to support (and not compete) with OK Falls Town Centre Plan objectives;
- Supports direction of 2013 OCP Review to encourage Medium Density Residential development in this area.
















Consultation
