OK Falls Town Centre Plan

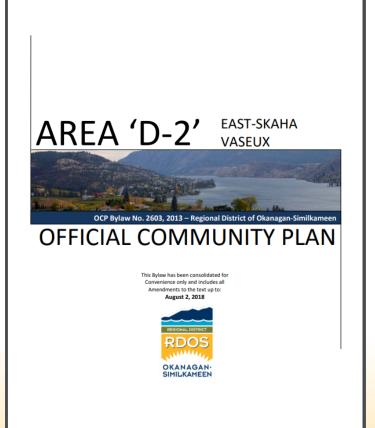
- commenced in 2014;

Town Centre Plan Study Area



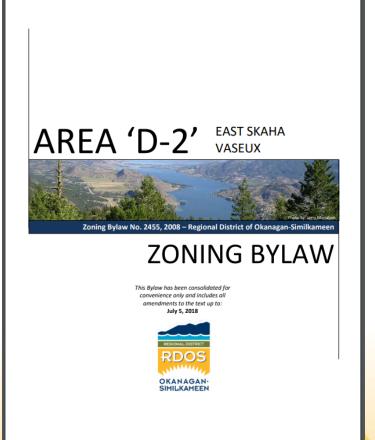

- new "Town Centre" land use designation (i.e. objectives and policies);
- new Development Permit Area Design Guidelines;
- proposed location for a public square (i.e. "Place Magnet"); and
- proposed local road upgrading, sidewalk & trail connections, parkspace, and lake access.



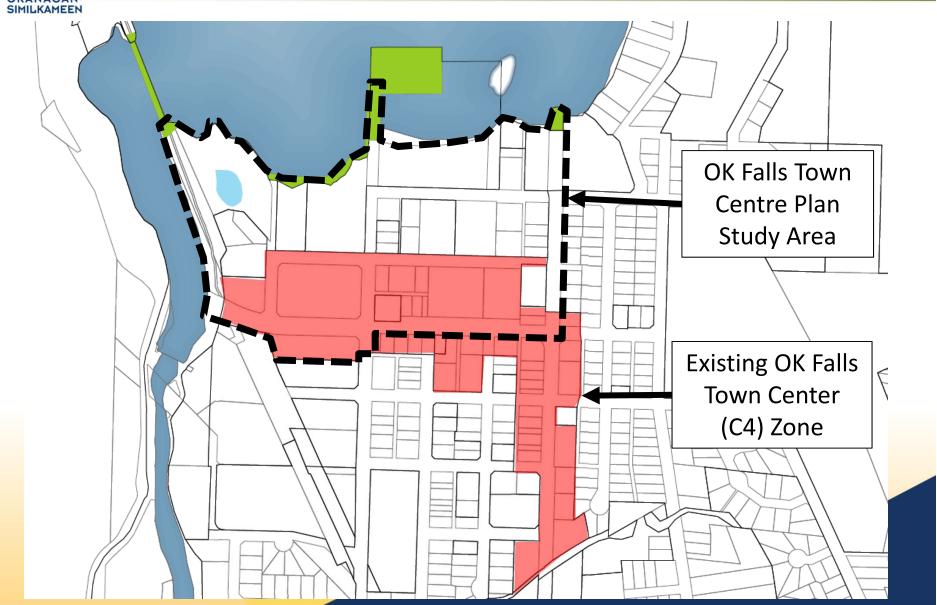

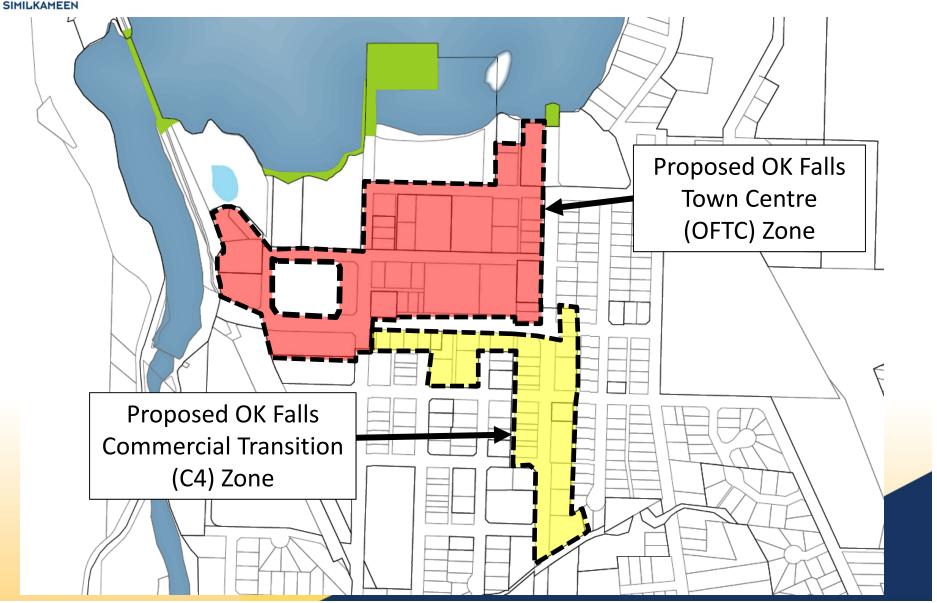
Recommended Amendments to Zoning Bylaw:

PA review of the Okanagan Falls
Town Centre (C4) Zone should be
undertaken in order to ensure
consistency with the objectives and
policies of the Town Centre (TC)
designation under the OCP Bylaw
(i.e. allow medium density
residential development ...)











Affected Zones:

- OK Falls Town Centre (C4);
- Tourist Commercial One (CT1);
- Tourist Commercial Four (Campground) (CT4);
- Residential Single Family One (RS1);
- Residential Multiple Family (RM1).



- 1. Permitted Uses
- 2. Density
- 3. Building Envelopes



Proposed OFTC Zone Uses (community):

- art gallery library, museum;
- church;
- community hall;
- educational facility;



Proposed OFTC Zone Uses (commercial):

- brewery, cidery, distillery or winery;
- eating and drinking establishment;
- indoor recreational facilities;
- tourist accommodation (i.e. hotel/motel);
- offices;
- outdoor market;
- personal services establishment;
- retail stores, general;



Proposed OFTC Zone Uses (residential):

- multi-unit dwellings*
 (i.e. apartment buildings)
 - > Maximum Density: 60 units/ha
 - Minimum Density: 3 units
 - Maximum Floor Area Ratio: n/a
- * This use will no longer be required to provide commercial space at ground floor.



Permitted Uses - impacts:

RM1 Zone

- boarding homes;
- congregate care house;
- duplex;
- group homes;
- single detached dwelling.

RS1 Zone

 single detached dwelling.

CT4 Zone

campground.

These uses will not be permitted in OFTC Zone



OK Falls Town Centre DP Area:

Buildings are encouraged to "terrace down in height towards the north (Skaha lakefront) to optimize views towards the lake and sunlight penetration."

Proposed Building Heights: 15.0 metres (principal) 4.5 metres (accessory)

Comparison to existing zonings:

C4 Zone: 12.0 m (principal) / 4.5 m (accessory)

CT1 Zone: 12.0 m (principal)

RS1 Zone: 10.0 m (principal) / 5.5 m (accessory)

RM1 Zone: 12.0 m (principal) / 5.5 m (accessory)



OK Falls Town Centre DP Area:

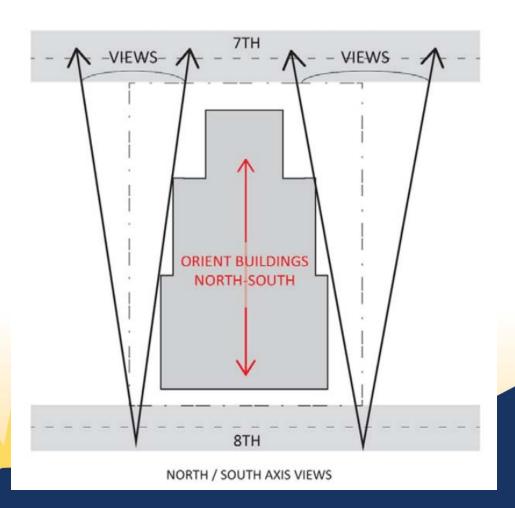
Buildings are encouraged to "step back the upper floors a minimum of 2.0 metres above





OK Falls Town Centre DP Area:

Buildings are encouraged to be sited "optimize sunlight penetration and optimize views and access towards the lake front."









Minimum Setbacks from parcel lines:

Buildings and structures: Accessory buildings:

Front: 0.0 metres Front: 6.0 metres

Rear: 0.0 metres Rear: 1.0 metres

Interior side: 0.0 metres Interior side: 1.5 metres

Exterior side: 0.0 metres Exterior side: 3.0 metres

For a parcel line adjacent Highway 97: 4.5 metres



Parcel Size:

Coverage: 80% 1,000 m²

C4 Zone: 80% **C4 Zone**: 500 m²

CT1 Zone: 35% **CT1 Zone**: 1,000 m²

CT4 Zone: 20% **CT4 Zone**: 1,000 m²

RS1 Zone: 35% **RS1 Zone**: 667 m²

RM1 Zone: 35% **RM1 Zone**: 1,000 m²



Vehicle Parking Requirements:

Commercial uses in OFTC Zone

50% reduction (subject to MoTI approval)

Residential uses in OFTC Zone

- no reduction
- current requirement is 1.75/unit (multi)
