I have witnessed (and confirmed by the guests themselves to me) that Bal Arneson and her daughter, Anoop, have made the property at 6851 Indian Rock available for rent as a vacation property from this Spring, 2024. Their unmaintained proptery is overgrown with towering weeds with garabage littering her their property and ours. Their light pollution is atrocious.

Bal Arneson told the previous renters to call the Naramata Fire department when her generator continued to turn on (no grid failure at the time) to resolved the issue - and has called the Penticton Police department with false allegations about me - proving that by not having an owner onsite, she will leach the resources of the community.
