



# PUBLIC HEARING

## **ELECTORAL AREA "G" ZONING BYLAW UPDATE PARKS AND NATURAL ENVIRONMENT ZONES**

The Regional District is proposing to expand zoning regulations within Electoral Area "G" by introducing new Conservation Area (CA) and Parks and Recreation (PR) Zones to Electoral Area "G" Zoning Bylaw No. 2781, 2017.

**Amendment Bylaw No. 2781.03, 2026**, proposes to replace Schedule '2' (Zoning Map) to include the CA and PR Zones, and to introduce new zoning regulations and definitions applicable to those zones.

The CA and PR Zones are proposed to apply to Crown/public lands within the electoral area which have corresponding CA and PR land use designations as established under the Electoral Area "G" Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2975, 2022.

This public hearing will take place on **March 5, 2026 at 9:00 am** and will be conducted in a hybrid fashion by video conference using Webex and in-person. If you would like to attend, please refer to the following meeting information:
