RE: Public Hearing Report - Amendment Bylaw No. 2498.19, 2019

Purpose of Bylaws:

The proposed amendments to the Electoral Area “H” Zoning Bylaw No. 2498.19, 2019, are to change the zoning designation of a portion of the property at 1500 Blakeburn Road from Large Holdings Two (LH2) to Site Specific Large Holdings Two (LH2s). The bylaw also proposes to introduce site-specific regulations to increase the maximum number of dwellings from 2 to 8, increase the maximum number of accessory dwellings from 0 to 1, and increase the minimum lot size from 8.0 ha to 60 ha.


J. Peachey, Planner I, outlined the proposed Bylaw.
