

Clean Water and Wastewater Grant Fund

In March 2017, the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) received a BC Clean Water/Wastewater Fund (CWWF) grant from the Federal and Provincial governments to help carry out a replacement project of approximately 5km of underground watermains in Naramata.

Hayman Road is one of the watermain replacement areas included within the CWWF grant. This work area will also include small portions of Lower Debeck Road and Old Main Road.

A map of the Hayman Road Watermain Upgrade project, including the portions of Lower Debeck Road and Old Main Road to be completed can be found on the back of this newsletter.

Ecora Engineering & Resource Group Ltd. (Ecora) completed the design for replacing these high priority watermains. The construction tender for Hayman Road Watermain Upgrades closed in June and Peters Bros. Construction Ltd. (Peters Bros.) was the successful proponent. They have subcontracted the civil work to Twin Con Enterprises Ltd. (Twin Con). The RDOS, Ecora, Peters Bros. and Twin Con will be working within your area over the next few months.

Construction will begin on June 22, 2017 with the reclaiming of the road asphalt. The existing asphalt surface will be broken up and mixed in with the top layer of gravel to allow for the watermain replacement. The gravel road surface will then be compacted for traffic use. Moving forward thru construction the road surface will be a gravel surface until such time as the civil work has been completed and the road can be repaved.

The construction for the Hayman Road Watermain Upgrades project is expected to last until the end of September 2017. During this time the RDOS, Ecora, Peters Bros. and Twin Con will strive to minimize the general inconvenience of having construction occurring within the area.

In the event of a planned service disruption or obstruction to accessing your property the contractor will notify you personally a minimum of 48 hours in advance.

The RDOS would like to thank the residents and businesses in advance for their cooperation, patience and understanding during the rehabilitation of their water system.
