


## How it all began....

- 1988 Waste Management Plan
  - Completed for all of Area D which included Skaha Estates, Kaleden and Okanagan Falls.
  - Detailed first potential layout of adding sewers to the communities of Skaha Estates and Kaleden
- 2005 Okanagan Falls Area Sewerage Study
  - o Examined options again and added new ideas
- 2007 Kaleden Lakeshore and Skaha Estates Sewage Treatment Options
  - Compared options of connecting to Okanagan Falls sewers versus constructing satellite WWTP for each community
  - o Results of 2007 report presented to residents
  - Survey was used to gauge public support for options
  - o Recommendation was to pump to the Okanagan Falls treatment plant
- 2010 LWMP 2010 Okanagan Falls Liquid Waste Management Plan
  - o Included Kaleden and Skaha Estates as future areas to be sewered.
  - o Updated estimated capital costs
- 2010 Detailed design and construction started for the new Okanagan Falls Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP)
  - o Construction started in 2011
  - o Commissioned in 2013 and old treatment plant was taken offline





- 2013 Infrastructure Priority Selection by Regional District Board of Directors
  - Sewering of Kaleden and Skaha Estates ranked as the highest priority of the Infrastructure projects for the Federal/Provincial grant program

## • 2014 Preliminary design was completed

- Detailed sewer collection system layouts for Skaha Estates and Kaleden communities were explored and refined
- o Investigated different conveyance options for reaching Okanagan Falls
  - Forcemains crossing the lake and shared connection into OK Falls
  - Forcemains kept separate down each side of the lake
- 2014 New Building Canada Fund Small Communities Fund grant 1st Intake
  Applied for in February 2014 but was unsuccessful
  - 2016 Public meetings to gauge support on options for grant application
    - Communities decided no lake crossing and to keep forcemains separate
- 2016 New Building Canada Fund Small Communities Fund grant 2nd Intake
  - Application was submitted in April 2016 Approved in 2017
- 2018 Predesign for Skaha Estates community completed
  - o Completed predesign with updated estimated cost of almost \$20M
  - o Grant was insufficient so transferred to Kaleden community
- 2020 Predesign for Kaleden community completed
  - o Initial referendum date of June 20<sup>th</sup> was postponed to October 2020
  - Website was set up to begin providing information to public as regular community event could not occur due to COVID restrictions
