RESIDENTIAL WATERING RESTRICTIONS FOR SYSTEM USERS STAGE 1



The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen is advising residents that **Stage 1** watering restrictions are in effect until further notice.

Stage 1 restrictions are intended to reduce total and peak use by <u>**10%**</u>.

Shaded Grey properties on map → Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

| Automated Irrigation Systems: 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM On your watering day Drip Irrigation Systems 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Three days per week | <u>Trees and</u> <u>Flowering Shrubs:</u> Any day at any time using any method for 21 days after planting of new trees and flowering shrubs. Stage 1 restrictions are required after 21 days | *Excess water use is defined as applying more water than is required to provide a service, produce a product, or complete a task | 10% Reduction |

Non-shaded properties on map → Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.


