



LOWER SAGE MESA WATER SYSTEM USERS **BOIL WATER NOTICE - REMINDER**

December 16, 2019

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (Operations contractor for the water system) would like to remind residents of the Lower Zone of the Sage Mesa water system (see addresses below) that the permanent **Boil Water Notice** (issued April, 2019) remains in effect.

This **Boil Water Notice** includes all properties with addresses on the following roads:

- **Sage Mesa Drive**
 - **Ladera Place**
 - **Solana Crescent**
 - **Pine Hills Drive**
 - **Verano Place**

This **Boil Water Notice** will remain in effect until the appropriate engineering upgrades are in place to provide the required chlorine contact time between the Lake Pump Station and the first customers of the system (the Lower Zone).

Residents are advised to use a safe alternate source of water or to boil water for all drinking, oral hygiene and food preparation/cooking purposes. Water should be brought to a full boil and allowed to boil for at least 1 minute to reduce the risk of infection from pathogens that may be found in the water.

The RDOS would also like to remind all business owners/operators (bed and breakfasts) and public facilities operators that it is the responsibility of said establishments to notify their customers of the **Boil Water Notice**.


