### CHLORINE PROJECT UPDATE

### BOIL WATER NOTICE STILL IN EFFECT

Over the next several days, Public Works staff and contractors will be commissioning the **Willowbrook Water** chlorination system.

Starting Thursday, you may notice the taste and odour of chlorine in the water. Water operators will be making adjustments, testing and sampling. Once we have enough samples to satisfy the Interior Health Authority’s (IHA) requirements, we will be able to finally lift the Boil Water Notice. We will send out an update lifting the Notice as soon as we have that confirmation from IHA.

**So for now, the Boil Water Notice is still in effect and you should continue to follow it.**

<p>On another note, we received a “low level” alarm from the reservoir last night (directly related to folks irrigating) resulting in an Operator call out. We would normally just see a low level alarm if there was a water break. Please remember to follow the Stage Normal watering restrictions so we can maintain enough water for fire suppression.</p>

If possible, please let any of your neighbours in the area know that may not have email or internet.


