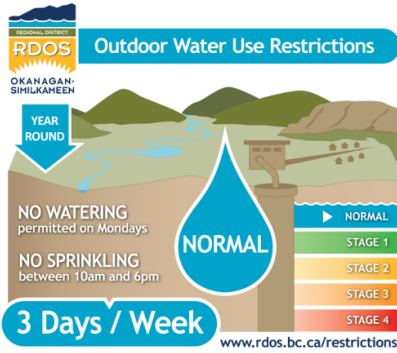
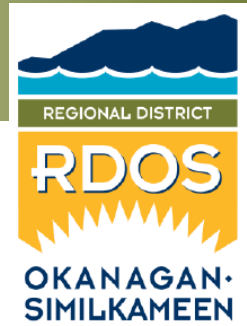

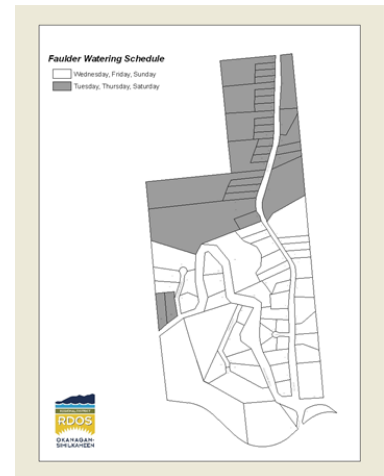
RESIDENTIAL WATERING RESTRICTIONS FOR SYSTEM USERS STAGE NORMAL

- 104 Fish Lake Rd. & all properties North and 8000 & 8008 Princeton-Summerland Rd. → Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday**
- 98 Fish Lake Rd. & all properties South, Princeton-Summerland Rd. & Mountain View Rd → Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday**

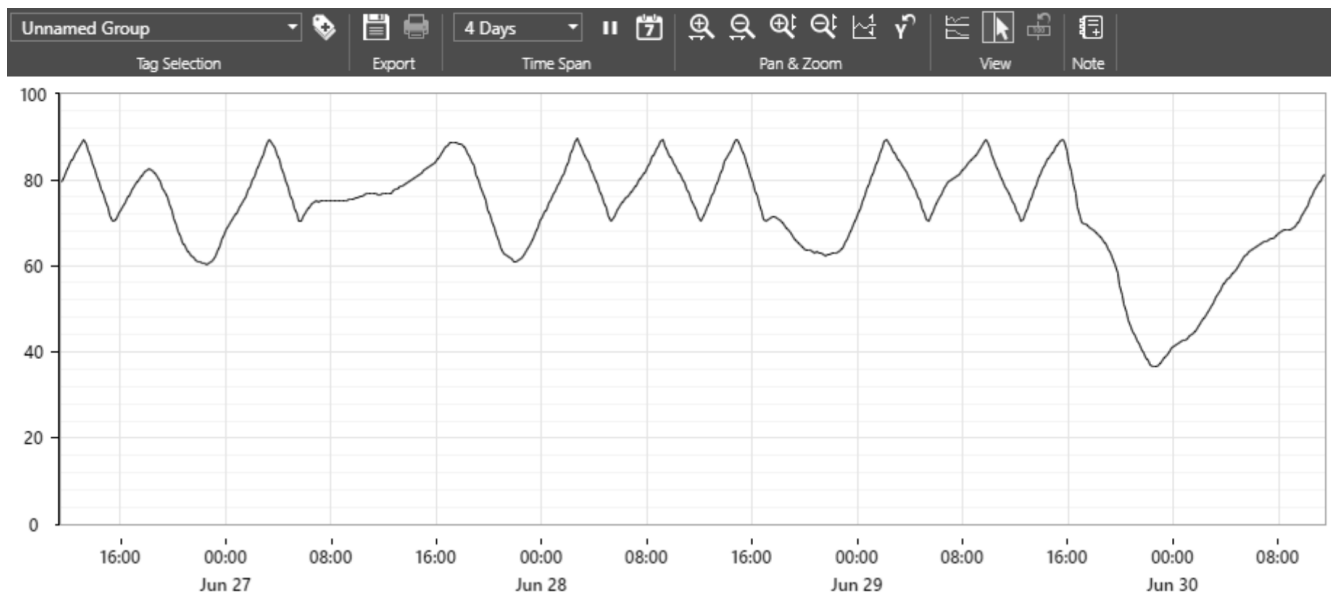
Over the past days due to the extreme heat wave, the water demand in the Faulder water system has exceeded the system’s supply capacity a number of times.

As a result, the pumps operate for extended periods of time while the water level in the storage reservoir continues to drop. This significantly increases the risk of the Faulder water system running out of water and could actually damage pumps and result in no water for an extended period of time.

The RDOS asks that you please conserve water where you can to help reduce the current demand on your water system. If the high use continues, we may need to move to more regimented regulations i.e. Stage 2 -4. Also, if the reservoir goes negative we will be required to call a Boil Water Notice in accordance with our Permit to Operate through the Interior Health Authority.



Hopefully things cool down a bit over the next while, but residents need to be diligent in conserving water supply, especially during the hot summer temps.
