The **EVACUATION ORDER**, pursuant to the Emergency Program Act, issued by the <u>Regional District of</u> <u>Okanagan-Similkameen</u> on July 31, 2023, 15:00 is **RESCINDED** for:

• Electoral Area "B" Frank Lake, South of Hwy 3 and East of Nighthawk Road

An Evacuation ALERT will remain in effect for this area.

An Evacuation Order may need to be reissued; however, if that is deemed necessary, the Evacuation Order process will re-commence.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Fill the gas tank of personal vehicles.
- Bring a minimum of three days of food and essential supplies (local grocery stores may not yet have adequate stock):
 - medications
 - pet supplies
- If your animals or livestock have been relocated, to coordinate their safe return call:
 - Animal Emergency Response Team (ALERT): 250-809-7152 Pet owners and hobby farmers
 - RDOS EOC: 250-490-4225 Commercial Farmers



EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTRE (EOC)



WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Prepare for the evacuation order.
- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence with family or friends, if possible commercial/hotel accommodation may not be available.
- Pack essential items such as:
 - government-issued ID
 - medications
 - eyeglasses
 - valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information)
 - immediate care needs for dependents and
 - *if* time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbors, if assistance is needed.
 - Consider evacuating, call the ESS at 250-486-1890 to discuss your options.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
 - **Pet owners and hobby farmers** with concerns for their animals may contact:
 - Animal Emergency Response Team (ALERT): 250-809-7152
 - Commercial Farmers contact the RDOS EOC 250-490-4225
- Arrange transportation for all your household members.
 - Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
 - If transportation assistance is needed, contact the RDOS EOC 250-490-4225.
- Please store your Fire Arms in accordance with Section 118 of the Fire Arms Act.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor news sources including Voyant Alert.
- Pre-register at ess.gov.bc.ca
 - You will need to either attend a reception center or call **250-486-1890** if the ALERT is expanded to an ORDER for immediate ESS services.

Emergency Support Services (ESS) is a safety net program available when alternatives such as family, friends, and insurance cannot be accessed. ESS is not offered if insurance is accessible. In situations where insurance exits, but cannot be immediately accessed, interim support may be provided.
