EVACUATION ORDER RESCINDED - August 4, 2023, 1530 hrs. **Eagle Bluff Wildfire**

The **EVACUATION ORDER**, Pursuant to Section 13 (1) of the BC Emergency Program Act issued by The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen on August 02, 2023 at 1530 hrs is **RESCINDED**.

The **Rescind Order** is in effect for the following areas:

- 14000 Strawberry Creek Road.

An Evacuation ALERT will remain in effect for this area.

An Evacuation Order may need to be reissued; however, if that is deemed necessary, the Evacuation Order process will re-commence.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Fill the gas tank of personal vehicles.
- Bring a minimum of three days of food and essential supplies (local grocery stores may not yet have adequate stock):
 - medications
 - pet supplies
- If your animals or livestock have been relocated, to coordinate their safe return call:
 - **Animal Emergency Response Team (ALERT): 250-809-7152 – Pet owners and hobby farmers**
 - **RDOS EOC: 250-490-4225 – Commercial Farmers**

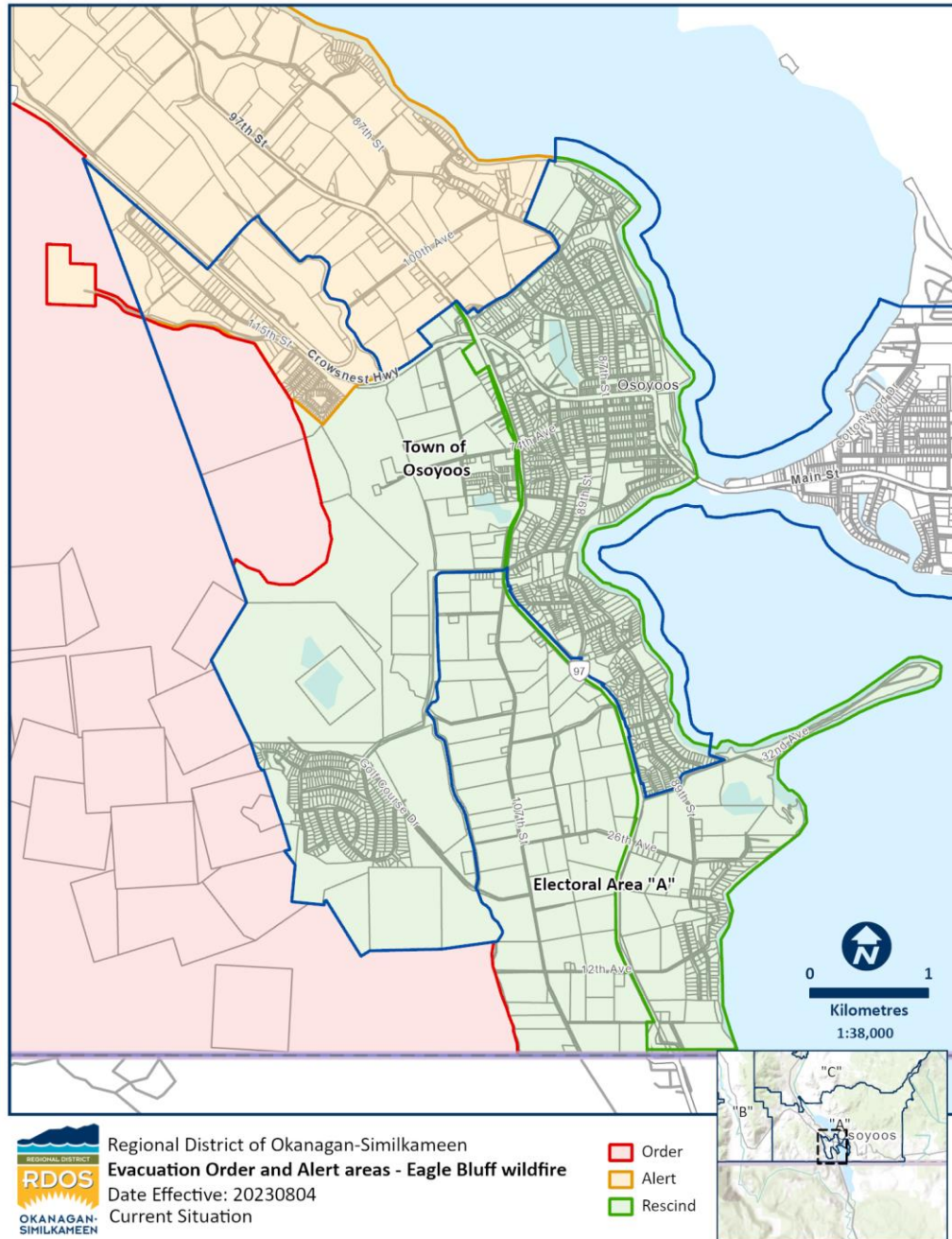
