OKANAGAN FALLS WATER SYSTEM

SPRING WATER SYSTEM FLUSHING

March 25, 2026

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) will be commencing the spring water system flushing program the week of March 30, 2026. This program will begin with flushing of the water mains in the Lower Zone and progress to the Upper Zone mid-to-late week.

Residents are advised to use a safe alternate source of water during flushing when preparing baby formula for infants and young children due to the potential for elevated manganese levels.

During flushing, residents may observe some discolouration or sediment in the water. If you experience dirty water, run an outside hosebib or cold-water tap until the water runs clear. Minimizing the amount of hot water usage will limit the amount of sediments that could settle in your hot water tank. Before laundering clothing, residents should check the water quality to minimize potential staining or discolouration. In addition, residents may also wish to isolate in-home treatment systems during the flushing program until turbidity has decreased to normal levels.

The RDOS is also recommending residents to flush their private water service lines and indoor plumbing, as sediments can accumulate in these pipes just as they do in the water system. This can be done by running all cold water taps within your property at the same time to remove any sediment buildup.

The RDOS would also like to remind all business owners/operators (hotels, motels, bed and breakfasts, restaurants, wineries, stores) and public facilities operators that it is the responsibility of said establishments to notify their customers of this Information Notice.


