The Evacuation Order pursuant to Section 107(1)(c) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* issued on August 26, 2026 for the following areas has been rescinded, as shown on the attached map:

- Lands east and west of Faulder and Darke Lake, Electoral Area "F";
- 1025 McLennan Road, 1015 McLennan Road and 1055 McLennan Road, Electoral Area "F".

An Evacuation Order or Alert may need to be reissued; however, if that is deemed necessary, the Evacuation Order or Alert process will recommence.

If, upon returning home, you discover that electrical service has not been restored, please follow the steps outlined below to have your electrical connection re-established:

1. Contact a qualified electrician to assess any damage to the electrical service connection serving the home, garage, or other structures.
2. The electrician must obtain the required electrical permit and complete any necessary repairs or replacements to the meter base, service mast, secondary pole, service conductors, or other customer-owned electrical equipment.
3. Once the repairs are complete, contact BC Hydro Express Connect at (1-877-520-1355) to declare the permit. Upon receipt of the permit declaration, Express Connect will create a work order and dispatch field crews to reconnect the service. Indicate that the damage and service request are wildfire-related.
4. Upon receiving the work order, BC Hydro crews will prioritize the reconnection and complete the service connection as soon as operationally possible.

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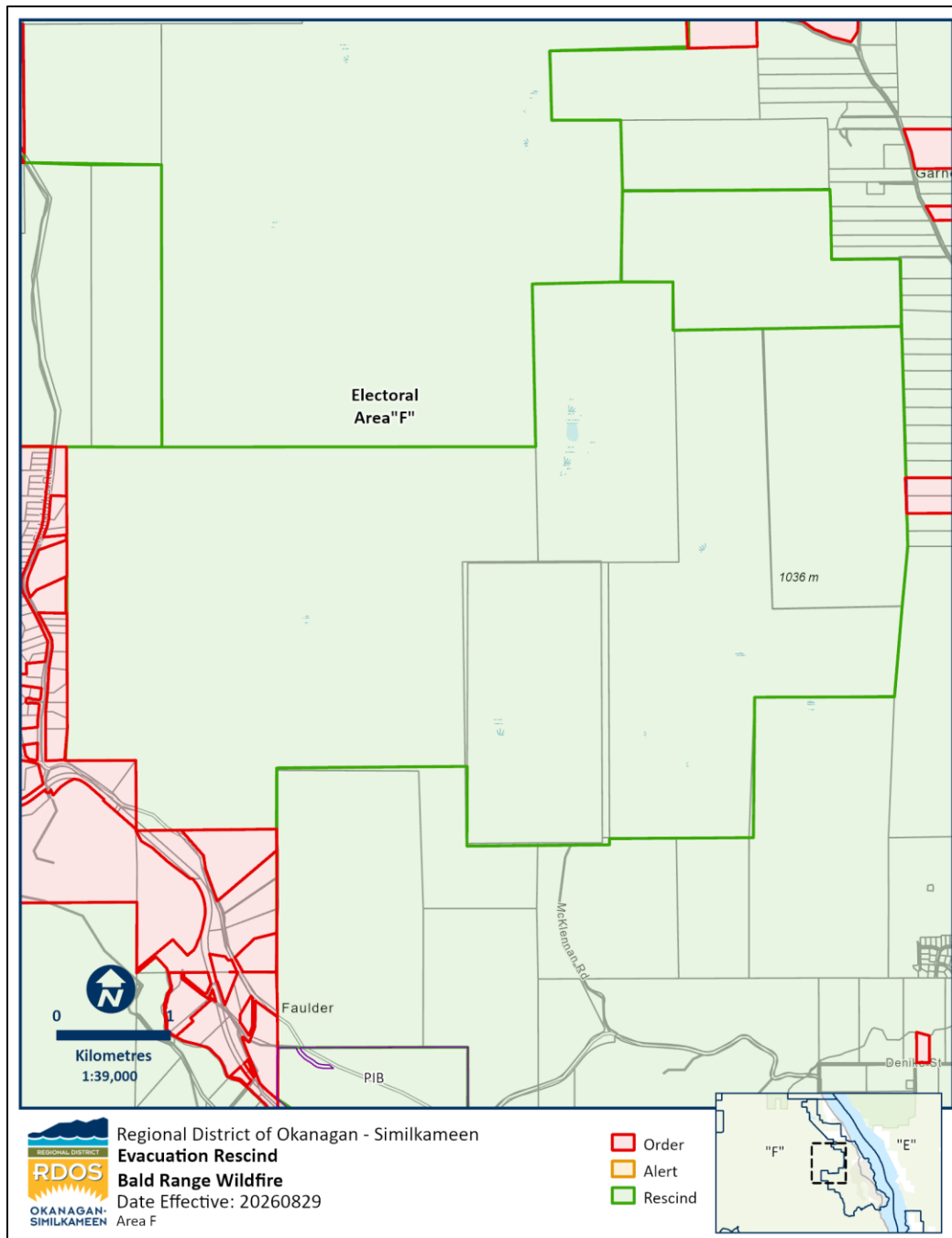

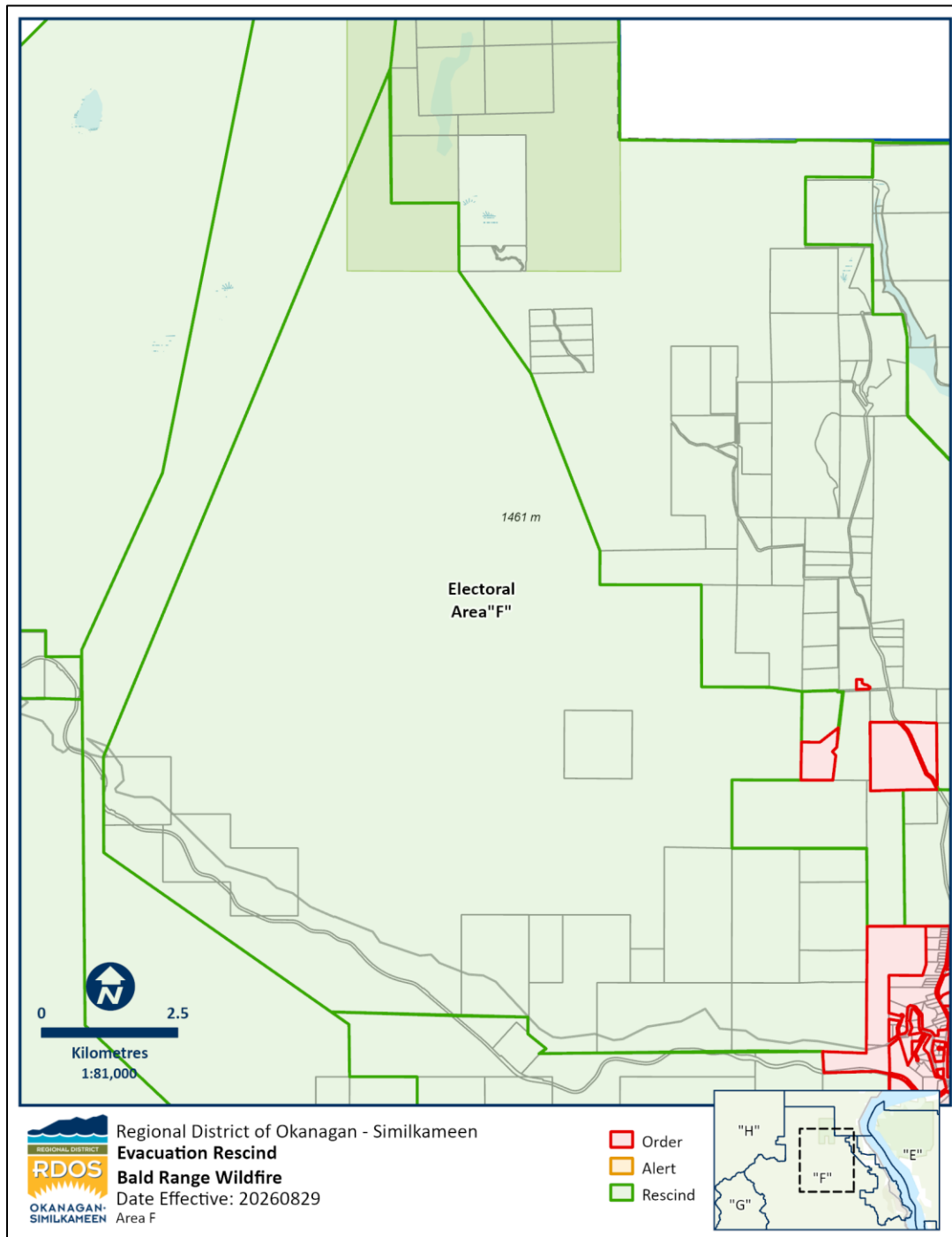
