

## CONTAINER SPECIFICATIONS

- **Max weight bag/can:** 25 kg (55 lbs) for any bag/can
- **Max volume bag/can:** less than 120L per bag/can
- **Cans should have handles for lifting**
- **Rolling Carts (120 liters or larger)** must have bar half way up front side to allow for lifting

## CURBSIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION - WEEKLY

- Garbage pickup every **Tuesday** starting 7:00 am
- **Never place out garbage overnight unless in bear resistant cart or enclosure**
- 2 bag or can weekly limit or 1 rolling cart (240 liter)
- **More garbage?** Place **'Tag-a-Bag'** stickers on extra bags as needed.
- RDOS **'Tag-a-bag'** stickers can be purchased at the Osoyoos Town Office, RDOS Main Office or Oliver Buy-Low Foods for **\$1.50** each.

## YARD WASTE COLLECTION – SEASONAL

During indicated Yard Waste collection days, place out an unlimited amount of residential yard waste in the following types of containers by 7:00 am:

- Clearly marked garbage cans, paper bags for yard waste or rolling carts with lifting bar,
- Free **"Yard Waste Only"** stickers available to mark cans or carts, contact Regional District for stickers
- Bundle sticks - using string or twine 1 m (3') max length
- Branch max diameter 7.5 cm (3")



**NO plastic bags, garbage, food scraps, rocks, sod, stumps, pots / trays or animal droppings.**

## LARGE ITEMS COLLECTION- ONCE PER YEAR

On **April 12<sup>th</sup>**, maximum **2 items** per household:

- Only furniture, fridges, freezers, large appliances and mattresses collected.
- **Max weight:** 90 kg (200 lbs) per item.
- **NO** renovation waste including toilets, water tanks, carpet, heat pumps, furnaces, plumbing and doors.
- **NO** televisions or computer monitors. Take **all** electronics and small appliances (TVs, monitors, computers, etc) to the Osoyoos Bottle Depot or Oliver Bottle Depot for free recycling.
- **NO** barbeques, lawn mowers or power tools.



## RECYCLING – ALTERNATING WEEKS

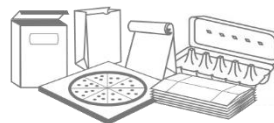
During indicated Recycling collection days, place out an unlimited amount of residential recycling in the following types of containers by 7:00 am:

- Clearly marked cans or rolling carts with lifting bar
- Bundle cardboard with tape or twine. Max size 65cm (2') by 1m (3') by 15cm (6") deep.
- Shredded paper allowed in one clear bag
- Free **"Recycle Only"** stickers available to mark cans or carts, contact Regional District

All accepted clean and dry recycling listed below must be placed loose in same container.



**Printed Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, envelopes, telephone directories, catalogues. Shredded paper in own clear plastic bag.  
**NO books or padded envelopes**



**Dry Paper Packaging:** bags, boxes, cardboard, paper cartons  
**NO waxed cardboard, tissue, napkins or paper lined with foil**



**Coated Paper Packaging:**  
Paper cups, milk cartons, tetra-paks, ice cream boxes  
**NO straws**



**Plastic Packaging:**  
Bottles, trays, tubs and 'clamshell' food packaging.  
Include caps/lids separately.  
**NO styrofoam, bags, pouches, wrappers or other plastic items**

**NO PLASTIC BAGS!**



**Metal Packaging:**  
Cans, metal lids, paper cans, empty non-hazardous aerosol sprays, pie plates, foil.  
Include caps/lids separately.  
**NO scrap metal, batteries or other metal items**

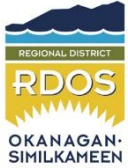
