



EVACUATION ORDER PARTIALLY DOWNGRADED TO EVACUATION ALERT

August 14, 2026

Pursuant to the Emergency and Disaster Management Act, the EVACUATION ORDER issued on August 8, 2026, at 0:10 (12:10am) for the District of Summerland in its entirety, is being **partially rescinded** and replaced with the following EVACUATION ALERT by the District of Summerland effective as of August 14, 2026 at 12:00 (noon) for.

Trout Creek Neighbourhood, East of Highway 97.

ALL properties in the specified area above, and on the attached map, will remain on an EVACUATION ALERT. All properties within the District of Summerland, not included in the specified area above and on the attached map, will remain on EVACUATION ORDER until further notice. The State of Local Emergency remains in effect.

A Boil Water Advisory remains in effect for this area.

If a subsequent evacuation is necessary, a new order will be made.
