

### **Curbside Collection Program**

- RDOS Curbside Collection has changed to automated collection and requires standardized carts.
- Curbside pick-up times can vary, place carts to the curb before 7:00 am to ensure they get picked up.
- Do not leave garbage or recycling at the curb overnight.
- · Only RDOS carts will be collected from.
- Write your address on the white space on the front of the cart and record the serial number to avoid mix-ups.
- Carts are assigned to the property. Do not take carts when you move and do not swap with others.
- Need different cart sizes or new carts? Visit rdos.bc.ca/curbside to see cart size options and request a cart change-out. A \$45 delivery/admin fee applies.
- Damaged, lost, or stolen carts? Contact the Solid Waste Hotline.
- Place your cart so the arrows on the lid are facing the roadway, and the wheels are by the curb.
- Make sure there is a one metre (3 feet) space in between carts and a 3 metre clearance space above carts.



# **Garbage - Weekly**

- Garbage will only be collected if in an RDOS cart. Make sure lid can close and do not over stuff.
- More garbage? Place Tag-a-Bag stickers on extra bags as needed. RDOS Tag-a-Bag stickers can be purchased at the Osoyoos Town Office, RDOS Main Office or Oliver Buy-Low Foods for \$2.50 each. Stick the tag on the top of the bag and place it next to your garbage cart.
- Wildlife-resistant carts must be unclipped or they will not be collected from.

No batteries, hazardous waste, or recyclables.

#### Yard Waste

On regular collection days, yard waste will only be collected if in an RDOS cart.

• Branch max diameter 7.5 cm (3").

No plastic bags, food scraps, rocks, sod, stumps, pots/trays, pet waste, compostable plastic, or invasive plants.

#### **Unlimited Yard Waste**

Place out an unlimited amount of residential yard waste in clearly marked cans, carts, or paper bags.

- Free 'Yard Waste Only' stickers available from RDOS.
- Place at your regular collection point.
- Bundle sticks using string or twine 1 m (3') max length.

#### Large Items – Once per year

Maximum 2 items per household – Accepted items:

- Furniture, carpets, fridge, freezer, BBQ (hoses, tank, oil drip pan removed), large appliances (no hot water tank), mattresses, gym equipment.
- Max weight: 90kg (200lbs) per item.

# Recycling – Biweekly

- Place recycling loose in the cart with no plastic bags.
- Shredded paper allowed in paper bag or paper box.
- Placing non-recyclable materials in your recycle cart could result in the cart not being collected from.
- For what's accepted, see recyclebc.ca. Must be clean & dry. Do not nest cans or boxes inside each other. No food residue or liquids.

No electronics, glass, flexible plastic, styrofoam, scrap metal, batteries, or books.

**Printed Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, envelopes, telephone directories, catalogues. Shredded paper in its own paper bag. **No books or padded envelopes**.

Dry Paper Packaging: bags, boxes, cardboard, take-out containers, coffee cups, paper cartons, clean pizza boxes. No waxed cardboard, tissue, napkins, or paper lined with foil.

Coated Paper Packaging: Paper cups, tetra-paks, ice cream boxes. Milk & plant-based drink containers now have a deposit and are returnable to a Bottle Depot or place in curbside recycling. No paper straws.

Plastic: Plastic containers, straws, trays, tubs, and 'clamshell' food packaging, cutlery. Include caps/lids separately. No styrofoam, bags, pouches, wrappers, squeeze tubs, toys, rigid totes, or other plastic items.

Metal: Food cans, lids, empty non-hazardous aerosol sprays, pie plates, foil. Include caps/lids separately. No scrap metal, tanks, batteries, paint cans, or other metal items.
