This is the only current process for TAPs:

Submitting an application does not guarantee access.

Wait for approval before going to a roadblock. Do not wait at a checkpoint.

Access points must remain clear for emergency responders.

Reapplying will not speed up your request.

RV services: Midtown RV, 310 Industrial Avenue West. Sanitary disposal and potable water. Monday-Friday 8:00 am-5:00 pm.
