



SAGE MESA WATER SYSTEM NOTICE

UPPER ZONE - WATER QUALITY ADVISORY (TURBIDITY) **RESCINDED**

LOWER ZONE - PERMANENT BOIL WATER NOTICE **REMINDER**

June 24, 2025

Turbidity at the Okanagan Lake intake for the Sage Mesa water system has decreased below 1 NTU to a "GOOD" rating. In consultation with the Interior Health Authority (IHA), the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) is **rescinding** the **Water Quality Advisory** (for turbidity) that has been in effect for the **Upper Zone** (see addresses below) of the Sage Mesa water system:

Please note that the permanent Boil Water Notice remains in effect for the Lower Zone of the Sage Mesa water system.

The RDOS is reminding all business owners/operators (bed and breakfasts) and public facilities operators that it is the responsibility of said establishments to notify their customers of the **Boil Water Notice**.
