The RDOS, along with a contractor, will be performing work in the Lower Zone that may stir up sediment in the water system and require flushing of the water mains to remove. If you do encounter sediment or discolouration of your water, the RDOS asks for your patience and to follow the recommendations listed below.

If you experience discolouration or sediment in the water, run your cold-water taps only and/or garden hose until the water runs clear. Minimizing the amount of hot water usage will limit the amount of sediment that could enter and settle out in your hot water tank.

In addition, residents should check the water quality before laundering clothing during this time to minimize potential staining or discolouration.


Residents with infants and young children in the Lower Zone are advised to use a safe alternate source of water during this time when preparing baby formula due to the potential for elevated manganese levels.
