MISSEZULA LAKE WATER SYSTEM

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) is issuing a **Boil Water Notice** effective immediately for the entire Missezula Lake water system. This notice is in response to a chlorine equipment failure and will remain in effect until further notice.

All residents are advised to use a safe alternate source of water or to boil water for all drinking, brushing teeth, food preparation/cooking purposes and ice making. Water should be brought to a full boil and allowed to boil for at least one (1) minute.

The RDOS is also reminding all business owners/operators (bed and breakfasts), landlords and public facilities operators that it is the responsibility of these establishments to notify their customers of the **Boil Water Notice**.
