



NOTICE TO ALL NARAMATA IRRIGATION CUSTOMERS

IRRIGATION TURN-ON

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen Public Works crew will commence spring irrigation turn-ons the week of:

April 13, 2026

If you do not wish to have your private system pressurized, please take whatever precautions are necessary to protect your private systems.

Please take note of the following before activating your private system:

- **BACKFLOW PREVENTION** is required for all fertigation, underground sprinkler systems, commercial/industrial connections and spray fillers.

Please note that all test reports for backflow preventers must be submitted within thirty (30) days of the irrigation turn-on date.
