This position is based at the Okanagan Falls Wastewater Treatment Plant.

- Chlorine Handling certificate.
- EOCP Water Distribution Operator Level I would be considered an asset.

- Instrumentation/SCADA programming and troubleshooting skills would be considered an asset.
- Certificate of Training for Transport of Dangerous Goods would be considered an asset.
- A minimum of 3 years' experience in a Class III or higher relevant water or wastewater system/facility.
- Knowledge of relevant policies, bylaws, procedures, safety methods and occupational hazards in the water operations and maintenance environment.
- Demonstrated computer skills in Microsoft Office Suite (Outlook, Word, and Excel).
- Ability to work on a number of concurrent tasks with deadline pressures and to work independently and efficiently with limited supervision.
- Ability to communicate in a courteous and tactful manner and to read blueprints and plans and prepare sketches.
- Ability to operate mechanical tools and equipment used in the operations, maintenance, installation, and repair of water and wastewater system works including precision work with small tolerances for error.
