

RDOS COVID-19 resource links and updates



- Wearing masks in public indoor settings is not required by public health.
- The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) does not require staff or members of the public (visiting Regional District facilities) to wear a mask.
- Wearing a mask is a personal choice. Masks are encouraged on public transit, but not required.
- Individual businesses and event organizers can choose to continue requiring masks on their premises.

View the province-wide restrictions effective as of April 8, 2022.

- Please do not participate in any recreation programs and services, or visit an RDOS facility if you have experienced any flu-like symptoms within the last 14 days.
- If you are self-isolating, under quarantine, or if you are currently ill please stay home.
