Purpose of Bylaws:

The proposed amendments to the Electoral Area "C", "D", "E", "F", "H", and "I" Official Community Plan (OCP) Bylaws under "Electoral Area Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 2913, 2020" are related to adding growth management policies for Agricultural Land Reserve (ALR) exclusion applications and to removing requirements for an agrologist assessment to accompany ALR exclusion applications.
