

Electoral Areas: "A", "C", "D", "E", "F", "H" and "I"


Purpose: Introduce policies for ALR exclusion applications by the RDOS





Agricultural Land Reserve (ALR) Exclusions

- Agricultural Land Commission Act amendments, effective September 30, 2020
- Private landowners no longer able to make an ALR exclusion application
- Only the Province, local government,
 First Nation or prescribed bodies can apply
- Public hearing requirements





Previous ALR exclusion application process

- Private landowner submits application to ALC
- Private landowner submits proof of advertising (notification sign, newspaper ads) with application
- RDOS reviews the application
- RDOS Board forwards to ALC or denies the application
- Newer OCP Bylaws include policy to require ALR exclusion applications be accompanied by an agrologist assessment






New application process

- RDOS now responsible for submitting ALR exclusion applications within its jurisdiction
- Public hearing now required
- Burden of application requirements shifts to RDOS
 - hard costs ads, signage, reports
 - soft costs administration/staff resources





- Removes policy statement under Agriculture to require agrologist report
- Applies to "D", "F", "H", and "I"

This bylaw has been consolidated for convenience only and includes all amendments to the text up to: July 2, 2020





- Will consider requests for the Regional District to initiate an exclusion application <u>only</u> within context of an OCP review
- No ad hoc applications
- Based on comprehensive review, not individual interests





OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN

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- Encourage property owners to seek alternative approvals, as an alternative to exclusion
- This could include a non-farm use, non-adhering residential use, subdivision, depending on what the property owner wishes to do





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Generally supports maintaining the integrity of the ALR and its existing boundaries


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Supporting the ALR

- Supports RGS Objective to "protect the agricultural land base"
- Supports OCP Policies that "maintain the integrity of agriculture in the area, by preserving land most suitable for agriculture and preventing fragmentation of large agricultural areas"
- Over 90% of ALR lands in areas with an OCP are either Agriculture (71%) or Resource Area (19%)





Summary

- Addresses concerns with limited staff resources being used for ad hoc requests
- Supports using exclusion as a "last resort"
- Supports reviewing potential exclusions as part of a broader land use review
- Aligns with Commissions' mandate to protect and enhance the size, integrity and continuity of the land base of the ALR
