RE: Noise Control Bylaw No. 2931, 2022

Administrative Recommendation:

THAT Bylaw No. 2931, 2022, being a bylaw of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen to consolidate existing bylaws and to establish regulations for noise control, be adopted; and
THAT Bylaw No. 2507.14, 2022t, a bylaw to amend the Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw, be adopted.

Purpose:

To introduce a new Noise Control Bylaw for Electoral Areas "C", "D", "E", "F" & "I".

Background:

At its meeting of July 22, 2021, the Planning and Development (P&D) Committee considered an amended noise control bylaw and resolved that the bylaw be referred to the Electoral Area Advisory Planning Commissions (APCs) for comment.

At its meeting of September 22, 2022, first, second and third reading of the Noise Regulation Bylaw No. 2931, 2022 and Bylaw Notice Enforcement Amendment Bylaw No. 2507.14, 2022 was approved.

Alternative:

THAT first, second and third readings of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen Noise Regulation Bylaw No. 2931, 2022, and Bylaw Notice Enforcement Amendment Bylaw No. 2507.14, 2022, be rescinded and the bylaws abandoned.
