

Agricultural Wood Waste Chipping Program

(for Orchard Full Tree Removal)

- **Step 1 – Register with RDOS before tree removal**

If you have pulled or cut trees, you may still register.

- **Step 2 – Free/No-Obligation On-Site Visit**

Chipping Contractor will visit site with Grower, provide site preparation details, an estimated quote, and Chipping Application

- **Step 3 – Submit Application Form & Fee**

If Grower decides to proceed with chipping, Grower submits Chipping Application Form and 25% of estimated quote for chipping to the RDOS

- **Step 4 – Chipping of Orchard Wood Waste**

Chipping Contractor will contact you to set a date for chipping.

NOTE: If the actual chipping fee is lower than estimated quote, RDOS will reimburse the Grower the difference. If the actual chipping fee is higher, there is no additional charge to the Grower, provided there has been no change in the estimated quantity.

Growers are responsible for making arrangements for, and paying fees associated with, pulling and gathering trees into piles. Additionally, the chipped material remains the responsibility and property of the Grower.
