Public Works Water Operators will commence the Fall Irrigation Connection Turn-Off:

THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 19, 2020

Please take whatever precautions necessary to winterize your private systems.

While this notice targets those with <u>separate irrigation connections</u>, it is also a great time for homeowners to check their *Pressure Reducing Valves (PRV's)* inside their homes and on their irrigation systems in higher pressure areas, to ensure they are working correctly and replace them as needed. PRV's help to protect plumbing fixtures from damage or breaks that may cause wasteful leaks. The life expectancy for PRV's is about 10 years.
