RESIDENTIAL WATERING RESTRICTIONS STAGE NORMAL

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen reminds Sun Valley Water System customers that **Stage Normal** watering restrictions are in effect **year round** or until situations change.

Even numbered properties **→ Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday**

Odd numbered properties -> Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday

The RDOS has implemented a new mass notification system for citizens and property owners within the regional district, called **CIVIC READY**. This new technology will enhance communication when it matters most; before, during and after an emergency event like floods or fires. *Also, for all RDOS owned and operated water systems, CIVIC READY will be useful for receiving notifications before any planned interruptions of service, such as utility project and construction events, power or water interruptions, and when water restriction stages are changed in response to local water supplies.*
