## **STAGE NORMAL**

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen reminds Willowbrook Water System customers that **Stage Normal** watering restrictions are in effect <u>year round</u> or until situations change.


Even numbered properties → Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday

Odd numbered properties → Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday

Watering Established Lawns, Shrubs/Flowers  Manual Sprinklers: 3 days per week 6:00 AM to 10:00 AM 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM On your watering day	Newly Planted Sod, Trees or Flowering Shrubs  Seeded lawns or turf: Any day at any time using any method for the first 49 days after installation of seeded lawns.	Driveways, sidewalks patios and decks: Any day, using any method provided it does not result in *Excess Water Use It is suggested to use a broom, or hose with spring loaded shut off	Topping Up/refilling Pools, Hot Tubs, Ponds or Water Features  Any day at any time for volumes under 4,000 litres  Note: for volumes above 40,000 litres, 24 hour notice must be provided to the RDOS
Automated irrigation systems  12:01 AM to 6:00 AM On your watering day	Trees and flowering shrubs:  Any day at any time using any method for 21 days after planting of new trees and flowering shrubs.  Stage 1 restriction are required after 21 days	* Excess water use is defined as applying more water than is required to provide a service, produce a product, or complete a task	
Hand watering of flower and vegetable gardens is allowed daily; drip or handheld	Stage 'Normal' represents normal conditions for the local area and your water system. Water Restriction Stages are important to conserve water, minimize pumping costs and maintain adequate volumes (flow) for fighting fire.
