TEMPORARY WATER SHUT DOWN FOR CHLORINE PROJECT TIE IN

RDOS Public Works crew and contractors will be shutting down the water supply July 7th. The shutdown is necessary for connecting the new water main to t he system.

WHEN:	Tuesday, July 7 th , 2020
TIME:	8:00 a.m5:00 p.m. (estimated)
AREAS AFFECTED:	All of Willowbrook

We anticipate this job to take approximately 8-9 hours. Residents should ensure a good supply of water is on hand for use throughout the day and for toilet flushing and hand washing etc. Irrigation should not be running at all on July 7th because there is a very limited amount of water in the small reservoir.

If possible, please let any of your neighbours in the area know that may not have email or internet. Once the work is completed, you may wish to run your cold water taps or outside hoses for a few minutes to flush any turbidity or cloudy water through prior to drinking or using for laundry etc.
