BOIL WATER NOTICE IS RESCINDED

RDOS Public Works staff are pleased to advise that the Interior Health Authority (IHA) has agreed to allow RDOS to rescind the Boil Water Notice effective immediately.

Excerpt from IHA Rescind Letter

“The treatment by chlorination has been approved based on providing 4-log inactivation of viruses meeting the criteria outline below. Therefore the BWN may be rescinded contingent on:

- a. A peak flow rate of 19 L/s;
- b. A minimum chlorine residual of 1.0 mg/L at the end of contact time; and
- c. A minimum CT of 8.0 mg/L-min”



Our goal as your water purveyor is to meet these requirements as long as operationally possible through monitoring and sampling.
