



REMINDER:

BOIL WATER NOTICE IN EFFECT

LAKESHORE WATER SYSTEM

August 12, 2026

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) would like to remind all users of the Lakeshore Water System that a **Boil Water Notice (BWN)** remains in effect for the entire water system. Recent results from weekly sampling have shown bacterial regrowth (Total Coliforms and background bacteria) in the water system after treatment, likely due to the increase in water temperature.

All residents are reminded to continue following the Boil Water Notice in place. Water system users are advised to use a safe alternate source of water or to boil water for all drinking, oral hygiene, and food preparation/cooking purposes. Water should be brought to a full boil and allowed to boil for at least one (1) minute to reduce the risk of infection from pathogens that may be found in the water.

The RDOS is reminding all business owners/operators (bed and breakfasts) and public facilities operators that it is the responsibility of said establishments to notify their customers of the Boil Water Notice.
